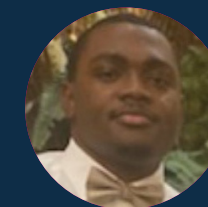

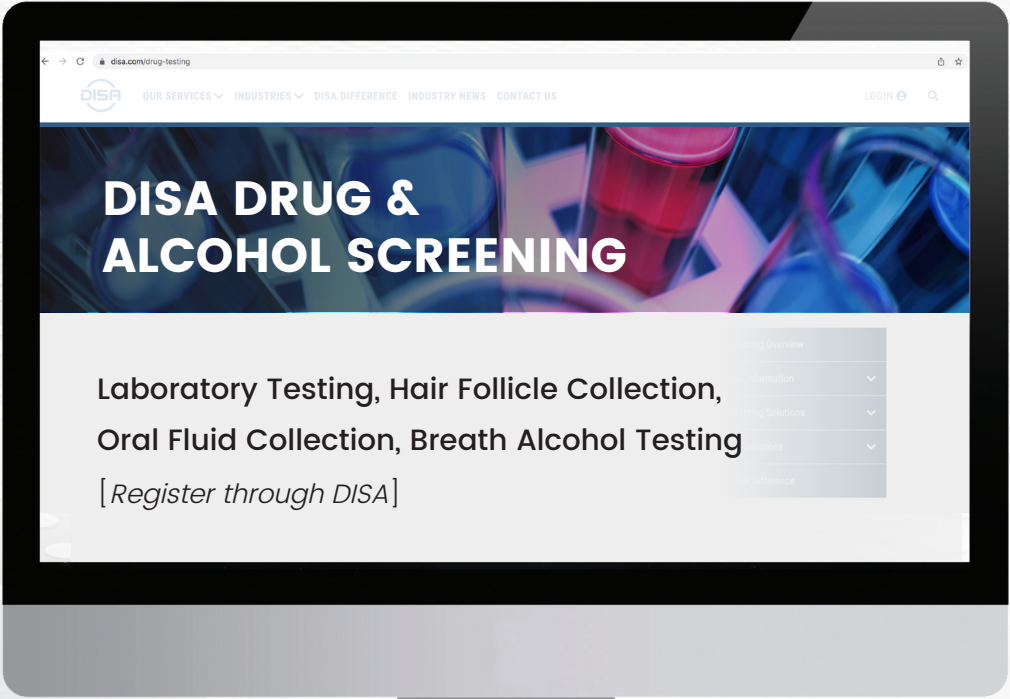

FALL PROTECTION

FALLS ARE THE MOST COMMON CONSTRUCTION SITE INJURY, MAKING UP ABOUT 35% OF ALL CONSTRUCTION ACCIDENTS. THESE TYPES OF INCIDENTS OCCUR WHEN A WORKER FALLS FROM SCAFFOLDING, LADDERS, ROOFS, CHIMNEYS, OR OTHER ELEVATED WORK PLATFORMS. OSHA RECOGNIZES THE SEVERITY OF THESE HAZARDS AND FALL PROTECTION HAS BEEN THE NUMBER 1 MOST FREQUENTLY CITED WORKPLACE STANDARD FOR 10 YEARS IN A ROW.

All workers covered by OSHA's fall protection standards must take fall protection training. Gulf Coast Safety Council offers two courses to help employees work safely and prevent OSHA violations.

GCSC Donates \$20,000 TO MADDOX LOUQUE

Maddox Louque, of Lutcher was diagnosed with kidney cancer in 2016 when doctors identified a stage 4 Wilms tumor. Maddox endured 6 weeks of chemotherapy to shrink the tumor and then had a left Nephrectomy. In October of 2016 Maddox was in remission. Sadly, 20 months later in January 2018 Maddox relapsed; more spots were found on his lungs. In March 2019 he completed round 7 of chemotherapy and received a stem cell transplant at MD Anderson Children's Cancer Hospital in Houston.

GULF COAST SAFETY COUNCIL SWINGIN' FOR SAFETY GOLF TOURNAMENT

On January 27, 2022 Blakely went in for a routine 9 month well-check visit where the doctor felt a mass on her stomach. After testing it was determined that Blakely had a Wilms tumor on her left kidney, also known as a Nephroblastoma, in addition to a small lesion on her right kidney. On top of this news, Abbie and Blake were in between jobs at the time and without insurance while still facing issues with the destruction of their home after Hurricane Ida. Blakely began 6 weeks of chemotherapy to shrink the mass on the left kidney and hopefully get rid of the one on the right. On March 25th Blakey had surgery to remove the left kidney completely. A 1 cm portion of the right kidney was also removed. She is currently receiving chemo every 2 weeks.

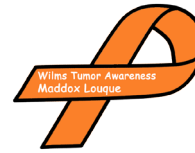
