## Close Calls - Hazard Awareness

## Did You Know...

- A "close call" or accident without injury is easy to shrug off and forget.
- There is a danger in brushing off accidents that don't hurt, harm or causes property loss.
- When a "close call" happens, it should immediately send up a red warning flag that something was wrong, unplanned, unexpected, and could happen again.
- The next time it happens, it could result in serious damage, injury or death.
- For every accident there are usually several contributing factors, most of which can be controlled.
- The best way to prevent the reoccurrence of an accident is by investigating "close calls" to identify the root causes. The investigation can be information. Then steps can be taken to eliminate the hazard and improve the work system.
- Inspect the work area daily for unsafe conditions or unsafe actions and correct them when found.
- Hazard awareness is key to preventing accidents beforehand.
